KYONGJU, Korea

The National Museum holds a bell which was formerly in the temple of Pondok in this city. About 280 cm high and

227 cm diameter, it is estimated at 72000 kg, the third-heaviest soundable bell in the world.

KYOTO, Japan
A bell of 63000 kg,
cast in 1614, is in the Hoko-ji
monastery. Another, cast in 1636, is
at Chion-in, and is nearly the same
weight; these were the largest cast in
Japan before the 20th century.

MINGUM sull'Irravaddi, Burma (also called Mingoon or Mingun)
A bell estimated at 90000 kg or at 88 tons; may be the largest soundable bell in the world. Cast in 1790, 366 cm high, 495cm diameter.

NANKING, China

A bell of over 20 tons, 2m diameter, cast in 712 by order of the emperor Hsüan Tsang, and still extant, apparently of Korean workmanship. Another cast in 1389 by order of the first Ming Dynasty emperor, nearly 360 cm high and 240 cm diameter, weight over 20 metric tons; extant. (Three others, made about the same time, and presumably similar, have disappeared.)

OSAKA, Japan

In the temple is a bell of 114000 kg cast in 1903.

PEKING (Beijing), China A bell of 56000 kg, cast in 1404 by Yao Kuang-hsiao, hangs in the Temple of the Great Bell.

PERTH, WA, Australia
The Swan Tower (see above) also holds
The ANZAC Bell, 6.5 tonnes, cast 2017
by Veem, Canning Vale, WA, and
first rung at 11 a.m. on 11 Nov 2017.

PYONG-YANG, Korea
In the city center is a bell of
10 tons cast in 1727.

RANGOON, Burma
The bell "Maha Ganda" (Sweet Voice) was cast in 1791 for Shwe Dagon; weight estimated at 16 tons.
Another bell, 42 tons, was cast 1840.

SEOUL, Korea

Buksoo Palace grounds hold the Queen's Bell, cast in 1462, 250cm high and 172cm diameter.

At Chong-ro, the ancient main central intersection in the city, is a temple bell cast in 1468, 280cm high, 228cm diameter.

WELLINGTON, New Zealand

The five basses of the War Memorial Carillon are as follows:

D# 27000 lb (1995) F 8.2 ton (1995) F# 7 ton (1995) G 6 ton (1995) G# 11129 lb (1929, G&J)

The four new basses were subcontracted by Whitechapel to Eijsbouts, and cast to G&J profiles using G&J decorations and bronze mix; the largest (at least) exceeded the capacity of Eijsbouts' furnaces and was cast at the NV Lips foundry for the casting of ships' propellors. It is the largest bell ever cast in the Netherlands.
