P.Hemony basses added in 1660 made this the largest & heaviest carillon in the world. The 1913 instrument included 38 by P.Hemony and 9 by O.Michaux. Now includes 8 Hemony bells from Baudeloo Abbey + 3 basses by others. Tower includes "Roland" by Michiels (1948), replacing cracked "Roland" by P.Hemony (1660), which is on display at ground level. Drum by P.Hemony, 1659.
